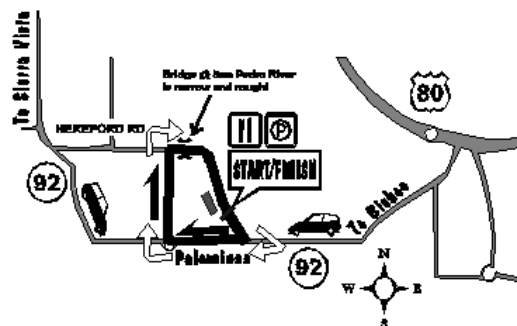


- DATE: Sunday, September 15, 1996; Ft. Huachuca, AZ [Registration opens @ 7:30 AM and closes 15 minutes prior to specific race].
- COURSE: 0.7 mile counterclockwise loop around the historic Brown Parade Field. The course is closed to traffic. The course has a slight rise to the west end.
- START/FINISH: Augur Street. You must let the attendants at the Main and East Gates know that you are going to the Criterium. Please park in parking lot to the north on Christy-Hines.
- SCHEDULE: Junior Boys/Girls 10-12: 20 minutes @ 8:01 am; Junior Boys/Girls 13-14: 20 minutes @ 8:00 am; Junior Men/Women 15-16: 30 minutes @ 8:31 am; Junior Men/Women 17-18: 30 minutes @ 8:30 am; Master Men 45+: 30 minutes @ 9:15 am; Citizen/Military: 30 minutes @ 10:00 am; Senior Women: 30 minutes @ 10:45 am; Master Men 30+: 45 minutes @ 11:30; Senior Men 4/5: 45 minutes @ 12:30 pm; & Senior Men 1-3: 60 minutes @ 1:30 pm.



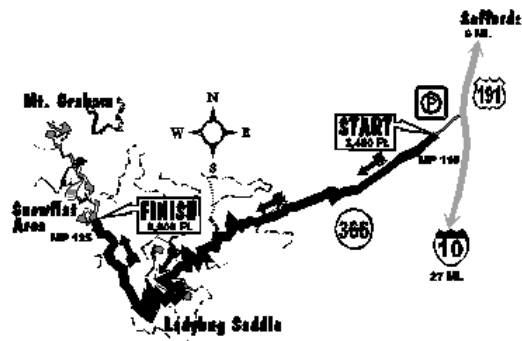
THE ARIZONA ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIPS



- DATE: Sunday, September 22, 1996; Hereford, AZ [Registration opens @ 6:00 AM and closes @ 7:15 AM].
- COURSE: 14 mile clockwise loop on Hereford Rd., State Rt. 92 & Palominas Rd., rolling with a slight climb to the finish. The course is open to traffic, be aware of cars turning onto road. Also, the corners are tight and the bridge on Hereford Rd. over the San Pedro River is narrow and rough!
- START/FINISH is one mile north of St. Rt. 92 on Hereford Rd. at about mile post 13. Please drive to S/F by way of St. Rt. 92. Please park off pavement along Hereford Rd. The feed zone is within walking distance, about 1/2 mile north of S/F. Neutral follow vehicles will be arranged on a volunteer basis. Every club that has riders entered should provide a vehicle.
- SCHEDULE: Senior Men 1-2 & 3: 7 laps @ 7:30 am; Senior Men 4/5: 5 laps @ 7:40 am; Master Men 30-34, 35-39 & 40-44: 5 laps @ 7:50 am; Senior Women 1-3 & 4: 4 laps @ 8:00 am; Master Men 45-49 & 50-54: 4 laps @ [1]; Junior Men 17-18: 4 laps @ [1]; Junior Men 15-16: 3 laps @ [1]; Master Men 55-59 & 60+: 3 laps @ [1]; Master Women 30-39 & 40+: 3 laps @ [1] Junior Women 15-18: 2 laps @ [1]; Junior Men 13-14: 2 laps @ [1]; Junior Boy 10-12: 1 lap @ [1]; Junior Girls 10-14: 1 lap @ [1]. [1] Riders will be started after 9:00 am as determined by the Chief Referee. You will be given 15 minutes notice, so be at the start area - ready to race.



THE ARIZONA HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIPS



- DATE: Sunday, October 13, 1996; Safford, AZ [Registration opens @ 7:00 AM and closes @ 8:00 AM]. Mass start road race starts @ 8:30 AM with Class/Categories as listed in the "ROAD RACE" above starting together.
- COURSE: 20 mile point to point that climbs 5,600 feet up the Swift Trail.
- START is at Mile Post 115 on State Route 366, across from the Federal Prison. FINISH is at Mile Post 135 near the Snowflat Recreation Area. Awards and refreshments will be presented at the finish area.



- AWARDS: Gold, silver and bronze Medals will be awarded to the first three riders in each class/category. "Arizona Champion" jerseys will be presented in Sr. Men 1-2 and Sr. Women 1-3 categories @ all four events. All other category champions may purchase jerseys at cost.
- ENTRY: Mail enclosed Athlete's Entry Blank and Release Agreement along with appropriate entry fees to: Albert N. Hopper, Jr.; Arizona District Representative, P. O. Box ABC, Bisbee, AZ, 85603. Entry fee for each event is \$15.00. A \$5.00 late entry surcharge will be added to entries received the day of the event.
